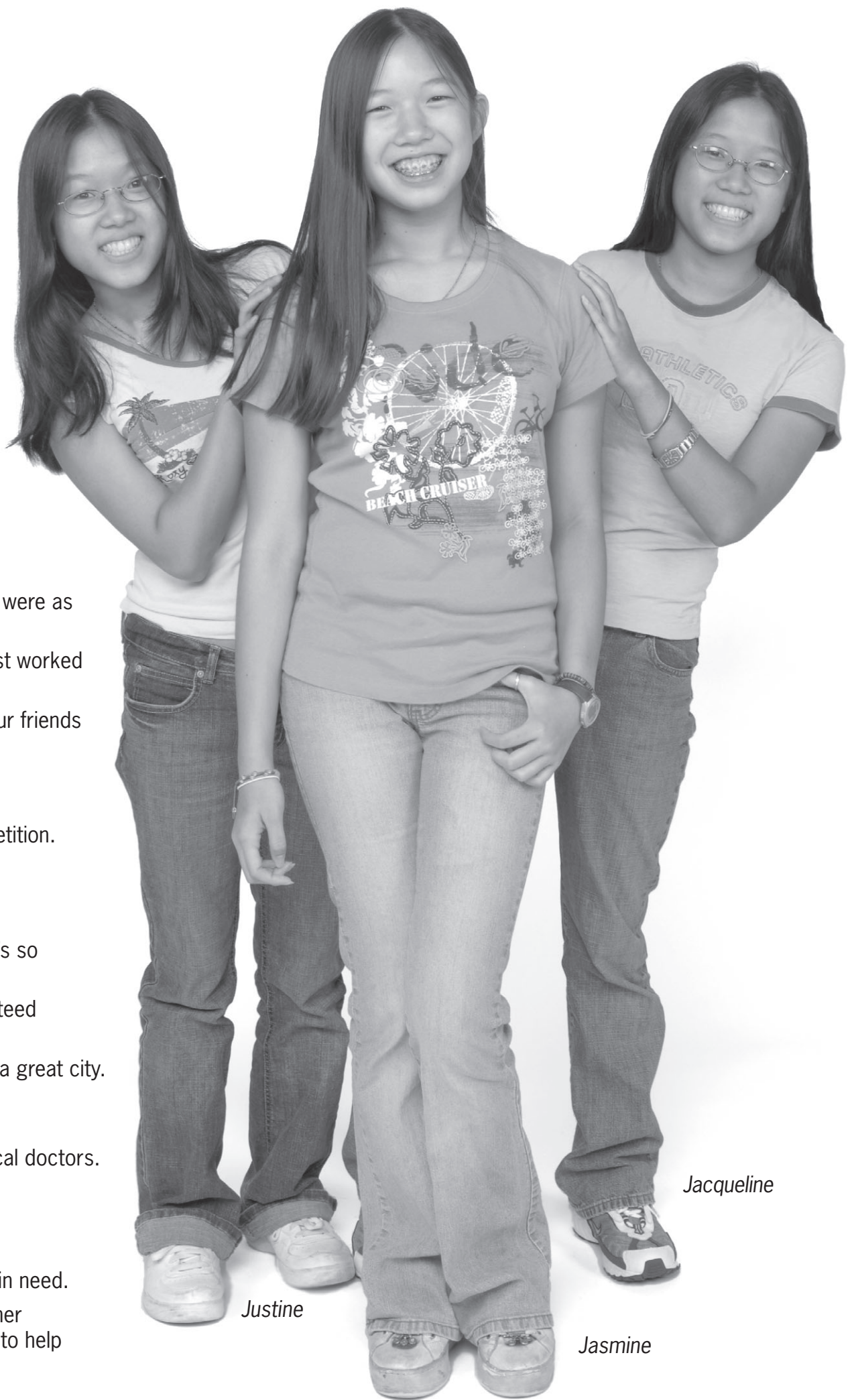


best *in class*
